



## Club Competition

The club is holding a competition to allow everyone, no matter how experienced at turning the opportunity to win a prize. The rules for the competition are as follows and the winner in each category will receive a cash prize.

The winner in the advanced category will also be deemed Club Turner of the Year and will be awarded to John Owen Memorial Shield with their name engraved on it.

## Competition Rules

1. There will be 3 categories:
  - Novice (been turning for less than 1 year)
  - Intermediate (been turning for less than 3 years)
  - Advanced (been turning for more than 3 years)
2. The competition will be displayed as the on-line December Club Table
3. The item is to be based on turning and must in the most part be turned
4. All entries are to have been made solely for the for the competition
5. No entries are to be shown prior to the competition
6. All entry pictures to be sent to Kevin by December 13<sup>th</sup> 2020 in the usual way
7. Entrants are entitled to vote for their own piece
8. The item in each Category with the most votes wins (the Chairman has the casting vote)
9. There are no restrictions on what can be turned in any of the three categories.
10. Each entry will be anonymous with a given number known only to Kevin
11. An Intermediate turner may enter the Advanced Category if they desire but not the Novice Category
12. An Advanced turner can only enter the Advanced Category
13. Voting will take place online any time after 13th December by sending an email to [competition@weston-woodturning-circle.co.uk](mailto:competition@weston-woodturning-circle.co.uk) quoting your name, category and the entry number. The winners to be announced at the AGM.
- 12 The Turner of the Year Shield will be engraved by the club and presented to the winner at the AGM (or as soon as possible) in January and can be kept for one year but must be returned to the club ready for the next competition. The Novice trophy should also be returned in time for the competition.
